I have the pleasure to send you the following information concerning the organisation of the *FINA Coaches Certification Webinar Course* – *Artistic Swimming Beginner Coach Level (LAT),* scheduled to be held in Latvia (LAT), on 9th, 16th, 23rd and 30th October 2021.

Please note the following information related to the FINA Coaches Certification Course :

Course description

- It takes place through the <u>FINA Learning Platform</u>, using the <u>Zoom</u> video conference tool.
- It is only accessible to those candidates approved through the FINA GMS.
- The webinar consists of four half-day sessions and online assignments. Registered candidates must be able to fully attend and participate in all sessions.
- The official working language for FINA Coaches Certification Courses is English.

Eligibility

- The FINA Coaches Certification Courses Artistic Swimming Beginner Coach Level are open to all the National Federations interested in training and certifying their coaches at a beginner level.
- They are designed for those candidates with no prior knowledge or coaching experience, preparing them for coaching duties in artistic swimming.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old at the start of the FINA Coaches Certification Programme.

- As per the <u>FINA Coaches Certification Pathway</u>, candidates must be registered through the FINA GMS by the established deadline and their profiles must include the following information: personal data, photo, passport/National ID copy and the candidate's <u>personal</u> email address. Any application without all the above mentioned information will be rejected.

Approvals

- FINA will start to approve the registrations once the required number of participants has been reached (10).
- The approvals will be done on a <u>first come first served basis</u>, provided that the maximum number of participants (30) has not been reached.

Webinar access

- Each approved participant will receive access to the <u>FINA</u> <u>Learning Platform</u> after the registration deadline.
- The login details and the webinar's instructions will be sent to the candidate's email address <u>as submitted in the registration</u>.

Assessment

- The official working language is English.
- In order to pass the course and become certified, a participant must pass the Online Course and the assessments available on the <u>FINA Learning Platform</u> before the end of the Face to Face Course. In addition, he/she must fully attend the Face to Face Course and pass the examination.
